**Kilmichael GAA** are again this year holding a fundraising event in aid of **Down Syndrome Cork - Tour de Munster 2021.**

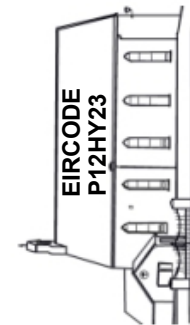
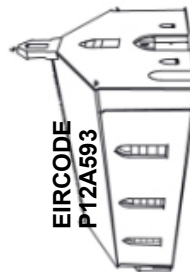
