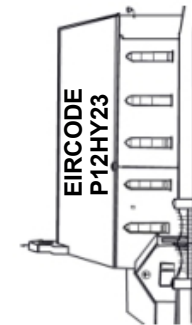
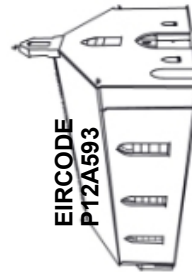
Cork Autism Online Conference 2021 - Thriving with Autism.
