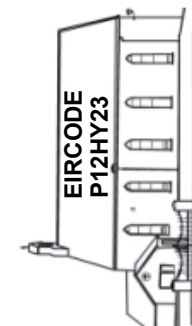
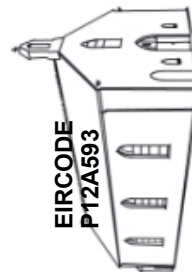
Terelton Baby and Toddler Group
