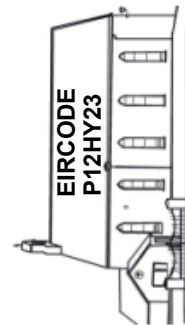
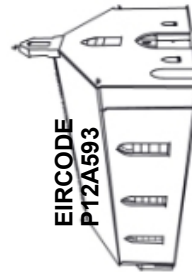

I hope everyone is keeping well. Great to see some of the Covid restrictions easing off. As one person said to me during the week, 'we have to start getting back to some sort of normality', how right they are.
This weekend we extend a very warm and positive welcome to the Bishop of our Dioceses, Bishop Fintan Gavin, to our very historical parish.
We have our church collections this weekend for the local branches of the Saint Vincent de Paul and I thank you in advance for your generosity.
The invoice for the painting of the interior of Cooldorrihy church came in this week and has been duly paid. It was exactly as quoted, €4,625. We also painted the wall behind the Altar in Johnstown which cost €250, this has also been paid. The total cost of painting Cooldorrihy church is €8,325 which includes €3,700 for the exterior. Thank you all for your kind and positive comments for this work. Carbery did an excellent job and were a pleasure to have them around the place. I also hired a carpet cleaner from Macroom Tool Hire and gave the carpet in Cooldorrihy church a good clean. Total cost was €43.51. Thank you as always for your generosity to enable this work to be done.
The next job is to layout extra graves in Terelton cemetery and that work will be done in due course. I also plan with the help of the cemetery committee to plant about 20 more trees there. This will include a mixture of apple and plum trees. All in good time!!
