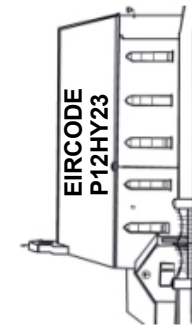
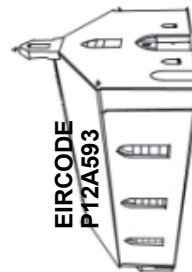
There's a 5KM walk /run every

*30 1888 16 # Facts of vestments: 1 green, 3 violet, 3 red, 1 black & white
 1 ciborium, 4 chalices all marked with names of churches
 3 large size altar portable altar stones, one small size
 for stations, all duly consecrated. 4 brass candlesticks
 on each of the three principal altars. 3 wooden tabernacles
 3 soutanes. 6 albs. 10 Annicts, 5 cinctures 14 corporals
 46 purificators, 24 palls, 8 finger towels, 6 coarse
 towels, 3 communion cloths, 3 chests of drawers.
 7 ladders. Ware in vesting rooms.*

Translation

May 30th 1888:

16 sets of vestments: 1 green, 3 violet, 3 red, 1 black, 8
 white; 1 ciborium, 4 chalices all marked with respective
 names of churches; 3 large size portable altar stones,
 one small size for stations, all duly consecrated. 4 brass
 candlesticks on each of the three principal altars. 3
 wooden tabernacles, 3 soutanes. 6 albs, 10 annicts, 5
 cinctures, 14 corporals, 46 purificators, 24 palls, 8
 finger towels, 6 coarse towels, 3 communion cloths, 3
 chests of drawers, 7 ladders, ware in vesting rooms.
