The annual Kilmichael Cemetery Mass will be celebrated in Macloneigh at 7.30 pm on Monday 30th May. This is the oldest cemetery in the parish and is of great importance historically as it is reputed to be the site of St. Finbarr's first church. It has the ruins of a medieval church and countless

generations of local people are buried there. This annual event is organised by Kilmichael Historical Society and everybody is welcome.



