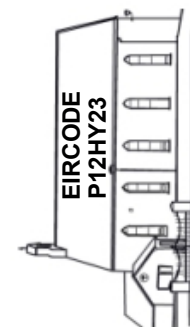
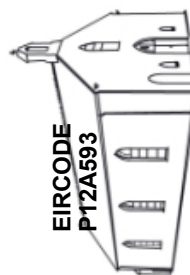
Croí na Gaeilge
