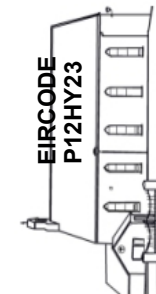
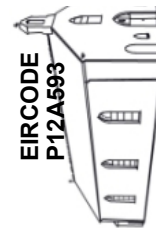
Shanacashel Community Center are delighted to announce that Santa will be returning to see all the boys and girls again this year. More details to follow soon.
