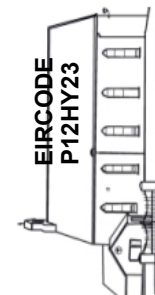
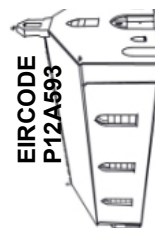
Ploughing Match

I want to take this opportunity to thank my lovely neighbours that have always been kind to me during my time there. I want to thank the Harrington family on behalf of the Parish and myself for their kindness and welcome over the years. Thankfully, I take with me many, many lovely memories of my time living in Clonmoyle as I move to Dunmanway, fifteen minutes away. I often think that it was rather strange that many of the Parish Priests before me lived in Clonmoyle and I am the last Parish Priest of Kilmichael bringing an end to a line of Parish Priests in Kilmichael since 1493. According to "Kilmichael Through The Ages" there has been a continuous unbroken line since the year 1700. To me this is very sad for the Parish. Sadly, a sign of the times we live in when it comes to our Catholic Faith. This is being repeated all over our diocese and our country. I can only hope that change will improve things as we try to interpret the plans of God. I can say a very difficult and emotional time for me personally and it will take me a bit of time to get used to the new set up.
