Lots of lovely bakes on offer, and a chance to sit down and chat in our school hall.

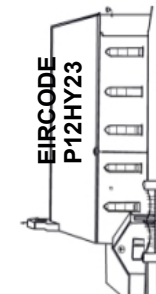
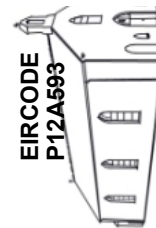
