


Full information on the role of deacons is given on our diocesan website (www.corkandross.org/vocation/the-permanent-diaconate). Please pray that those called to this ministry may respond positively. The calling of the first seven men is presented as a practical solution to a practical problem. Deacons today could also be a practical addition to parish life:

- They could preach at Sunday Mass with great authenticity, as married men/fathers.
- They could lead baptismal services and work with/develop baptism teams.
- They could provide an outreach to marginalised people, the poor, those on the edge (working with the VdeP
- They could do marriage services and help with pre-nuptial paperwork.
- They could lead every funeral rite except the Mass, working with funeral teams rather than instead of them, sustaining and encouraging lay involvement.
