appreciated.

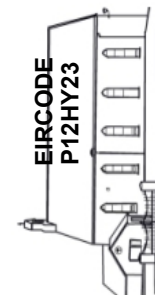
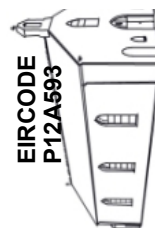
St Enda's N.S. Parents Association
