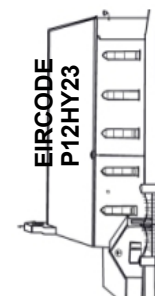
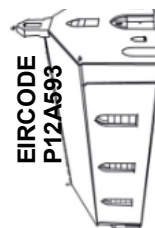
Macroom Senior Citizens
